Who can apply to be a retailer?

The qualifications of a retailer are the handicapped capable of working, aborigines, or single-parent families with low income.

Why can the general public sell lottery tickets?

- ✓ In order to consider the physical and mental condition of the retailers, who often have medical needs and are unable to handle long-term lottery sales, we offer an agent and employment system.
- ✓ However, the retailer should still understand that lottery tickets are sold in person and that the retailer's certificate cannot be transferred or loaned. If there is specific evidence (or corroboration) for a dummy retailer or according to the national consistency check requirements for a certain number of times to confirm that the retailer is not present, the retailer will be punished.
- ✓ The Issuing Institute is also equipped with a report line 0800-024-999 and a report box 110@taiwanlottery.com.tw. Since issuance began, the industry has investigated and disqualified retailers according to regulations.



How is the Public Welfare Lottery surplus used?

According to the Public Welfare Lottery Issuance Regulation and related acts, 50% of the Public Welfare Lottery surplus is allocated to 22 local governments across the country for social welfare purposes, 45% is used for the national pension system, and 5% is used for the National Health Insurance program.



What is the supervision for surplus utilization of the Public Welfare Lottery?

- ✓ The Ministry of Finance established a Public Welfare Lottery Supervising Committee that consists of representatives from central government, municipal as well as county (city) governments, related scholars, and social welfare communities.
- ✓ The Public Welfare Lottery Supervising Committee assesses allocated agencies and publishes its assessment results in an appropriate manner.
